My name is Elizabeth Swank, DAT, LAT, ATC and I am the Athletic Trainer for North Harford High School. I am looking forward to a wonderful season supporting the North Harford Hawks.

Reporting Injuries

It is very important that ALL injuries get reported to me <u>as soon as possible</u>. The resources available through the relationship with ATI Physical Therapy are designed to give your student athlete(s) the best and quickest care available. I am unable to offer these resources if I am unaware of injuries. If you are away at another school and an injury occurs, please call me with any questions. In addition to seeing myself, ATI Physical Therapy offers free injury screenings at all of our locations. Please call me and I can schedule a screening if desired.

Athletic Training Room Hours:

During all sports seasons I will be present for most home events. I will also be available to evaluate injuries at any time while I am on campus. Your coach will receive a monthly schedule of my availability. I will also be in contact with the school nurse.

Returning an Athlete to Play

It is school policy that any time an athlete seeks care from a physician for a condition that may affect athletic participation, the athlete may not return to play until we have a written note from the physician for releasing the athlete for participation. There is no exception to this rule. Parent notes are unacceptable.

Concussion Policy

According to Maryland State Law, any athlete that is suspected of having a concussion will be removed from athletic participation and must be evaluated by a physician. In order for the athlete to return to athletic competition, the certified athletic trainer and school nurse must receive a written clearance from a Physician, Nurse Practitioner, Physician's Assistant or a Neuropsychologist AND the athlete must complete a 6-step Graduated Return to Play Protocol progression.
